We are pleased you will be attending the 29th annual basketball camp this summer; your deposit has been received. This sheet includes general information which should tell you what you want to know before coming to camp. We are looking forward to some great basketball this summer. Bring along your enthusiasm and a real desire to play BASKETBALL!

TIME OF ARRIVAL: You should register at the Armington Physical Education Center, on The College of Wooster campus, between **1:00 and 2:45 p.m.** on the first day of camp. Rooms will be assigned at the time of registration. We will make every attempt to see that each camper rooms with her buddy. Only two (2) campers will be assigned per room. We will make every attempt to lodge teams together on a floor. Following registration, the campers will meet for introduction of staff and daily instruction.

ASSIGNMENT: Each camper will be assigned to a basketball group related to age, size, and individual ability.

ORIENTATION: Camp instruction begins at 3:00, on day of check-in/final registration, in the Timken Gymnasium.

BASKETBALLS: A free camp ball will be distributed at the conclusion of camp.

VALUABLES: Each camper will be assigned a key to her room. This room should be locked at all times except when she is using the room. **A camp bank will not be provided – room should be kept locked.**

CAMP LEAVE: No one may leave Camp without permission of the Camp Director.

BALANCE OF FEES: A key and meal card for each camper will be assigned at registration time. Your balance due is \$_____. Check or money order should be made payable to: **Wooster Basketball Camp for Girls. (Not The College of Wooster)**

DOCTOR'S STATEMENT: The enclosed medical and emergency form must be completed and handed in at registration.

PARENTS' VISIT: Your parents are invited to visit the camp at any time. We encourage your coach(es) to visit with us and watch. Preferred times are 6:30 – 8:30 pm as the campers are into 5 on 5 games.

AWARDS CEREMONY: On the concluding day of camp, at 7:10 p.m., there will be a closing ceremony held in the Timken gymnasium. This will give parents and campers an opportunity to meet with their respective coaches, and the Camp Director will make closing comments.

DEPARTURE TIME: Immediately following the awards presentation, approximately 7:30 – 8:30 p.m., check-out will take place in the dorms.
